The Feast of St. Ignatius Loyola

July 31

Monday, July 31, is the Feast of St. Ignatius Loyola, founder of the Jesuits. He was born in 1491 and as a young man was a soldier. In 1521 he was wounded during a siege at the fortress in Pamplona and it would be during his convalescence that he would begin to read the Life of Christ and undergo conversion. He began writing the Spiritual Exercises in 1522. His faith led him to Pilgrimage of the Holy Land and on several mendicant tours through Europe.
