Unbaptized Persons

Those who have never been baptized will follow the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA).

Baptized Christians

Those who have been baptized in another Christian faith community and desire to follow Jesus in the full communion of the Catholic Church will receive appropriate formation and, if they choose to join the Church, will make a public profession of faith.

Baptized Catholics

Baptized adult Catholics who have not received the Sacrament of Confirmation will follow an individualized path.

Perhaps you, or someone you know is considering becoming a Roman Catholic. The **Rite of Catholic Initiation for Adults** or RCIA is for you. The RCIA offers a communal program of preparation for those considering the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation & the Eucharist) and Reception into the Roman Catholic Community. Catechetical Sunday September 21, 2025

As part of a 1935 initiative to recognize and celebrate the gift that catechists give to their parish communities by giving of their time for the religious education and formation of others, the Church began what we know today as Catechetical Sunday.

Celebrated on the third Sunday of September, this is a time to come together to acknowledge the dedication of all those who serve as catechists in our parish family. It is also a day when parents, grandparents and guardians are also honoured because they are the true first catechists, sharing the catholic faith with their families. Catechetical Sunday is an opportunity for all Catholics to rededicate themselves to the mission of handing on the faith and being a witness to the Gospel as a community of faith.

The theme for this year's Catechetical Sunday is ***"Always be ready to give an explanation... for a reason for your hope."*** (1 Peter 3:15) The theme is a reminder of the call to missionary discipleship that we all share as Catholics. As part of the call to holiness, we take part in the mission that Christ left all his followers. We are called to widely share the message of message of Christ through our words and actions. The theme calls all Catholics to confidently, joyously and lovingly share the reason for our faith. It emphasizes the importance of forming disciples who can witness to Christ with clarity, compassion, conviction, and hope in everyday life. The theme also ties into the Jubilee Year's theme, "Pilgrims of Hope," a time for Catholics to renew their faith, seek forgiveness and reflect on the hope offered by Jesus Christ.
